

PROPER USE OF CREAMS & OINTMENTS

Procedure

- These products are for external use only.
- Wash your hands before applying the medication.
- Cleanse the skin area with soap and water each time you are ready to apply the medication. Unless otherwise instructed by your doctor.
- Gently, pat the washed skin area with a clean towel until almost dry.
- Apply a small amount of the medication to the affected area and spread lightly.
- Only the medication that is actually touching the skin will work.
- Do not bandage the area unless directed by your doctor.
- Wash your hands immediately after applying the medication. This avoids accidentally getting any medication in your eyes or mouth.

Special instructions

- This medication is for external use only. Do not place in eyes, nose or mouth.
- Do not use more frequently or in larger quantities than suggested by your doctor or pharmacist.
- Do not use for any other skin problems without checking with you doctor or pharmacist.
- Do not apply any other creams , lotions or cosmetics on top of the medication unless directed by your doctor.
- Call you doctor or pharmacist if the condition for which this drug was recommended persists or becomes worse, or if you have a constant irritation, such as burning or itching that was not there before you started this medication.
- Do not use or keep outdated medications
