

PROPER USE OF EAR DROPS

Procedure

- Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water just before starting.
- Avoid touching the dropper against the affected ear or any other surface.
- Hold the container in the hands for a few minutes to warm to near body temperature.
- If the drops are in a suspension form, shake well for 10 seconds before using.
- Lie on your side or tilt the affected ear up to ease administration.
- To allow drops to run in: for adults- hold the earlobe up and back; for children- hold the earlobe down and back.
- Place the prescribed number of drops in the ear.
- Do not insert the dropper into the ear. Do not wash the dropper.
- Keep the ear tilted for about 2 minutes, or gently insert a cotton plug, whichever is recommended by your doctor or pharmacist.
- Wipe the dropper with a clean tissue.



Special instructions

- Call your doctor if your condition persists or becomes worse, or if you experience any itching or burning in your ear for more than a few minutes after use.
- Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after using the ear drops.
- Keep container tightly closed when not in use.
